The U.S. Navy has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Statement/Overseas Environmental Impact Statement (EIS/OEIS) to re-evaluate potential environmental impacts associated with ongoing naval training and testing activities conducted within the Hawaii-Southern California Training and Testing EIS/OEIS Study Area. These activities include the use of active sonar and explosives while employing marine species protective mitigation measures, and are similar to the types of activities that have occurred in the Study Area for decades. The Navy is also conducting National Historic Preservation Act section 106 consultations regarding the potential effects on historic properties.
